Ways to Engage as a Church

Join CarePortal

CarePortal is a network that connects churches to the needs of children. A caseworker enters a need and churches in the network can see the request and respond.

Provide Classes or Q&A Sessions

The Attic can come in to talk about the local orphan crisis and how they can help or provide a support group for the current foster families in your church community

Cook a meal

We provide meals to families as they receive placements or have a difficult week. Churches can help us by cooking and packing freezer meals for us to distribute.

Become a Respite Provider or Babysitter

We can connect your church with Highsky or Buckner to help members become certified to help with respite or babysitting.

Become a Foster or Adoptive Family

We can help you connect families with agencies for training and licensing.

Adopt a Foster Family or Kinship Family

Assign a family to care for a foster family in your church. Bring them meals, pick up their groceries, watch other children as the parents tend to all of the schedule needs for the foster child. Pray for them!

Monthly Bed Drive-Sign up to provide a twin bed a month....or more!

Use your Handyman Skills

Sometimes families need home repairs or car repairs to provide a safe environment for their children.

CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate)

Become a volunteer and advocate for a child's best interests in the court system.

Hold a Drive

Gather donated gift cards, new pajamas, new toys, new shoes: all that would be given to children in the foster care system.

Adopt-a case-worker

Churches can "adopt" a CPS case worker to provide moral support or purchase items the case worker may need for a client. A gift card or encouraging note would help them feel appreciated.
